NEW GUIDELINES FOR BEST PERFORMING CHAPTER AWARD AND SCORING PATTERN

A "Best Performing Chapter Prize" has been instituted by the NSI Headquarters from the amount donated by the Mumbai Chapter. This is like a Corpus Fund under the title "Best Performing Chapter Prize Corpus Fund" in the books of accounts of the Society and interest accrued on that fund is used for award every year. The following new guidelines have been formulated for award of this Prize since 2023-2024:

- a) As per the decision taken in the 54th NSI Annual General Body, the best chapter awards will be given to 4 best performing chapters annually in four categories based on the **number of life members of the chapters**.
- **b)** The Chapters should organize their Chapter activities **UNDER ITS NSI BANNER.**
- c) The Chapters may conduct scientific activities such as Workshops, Symposia, Invited Guest (Special) Lectures, Panel Discussions and Extension and training activities like popular talks, radio talks, World Health Day, Word Breast Feeding Week, National Nutrition Week, World Food Day, National Science Day and film/Video shows, Exhibitions, Demonstrations, Quiz/Elocution competitions, Educational Camps etc., training or extension activities. The Chapters may organize some of the above activities such as Symposia, Special Lectures either on a Physical/Virtual mode or a Hybrid mode.
- d) Criteria for selection would be based on the merit of the above activities conducted by the chapter during the preceding year in their region of operation and the Chapter Report of the same submitted to the Headquarters.
- e) The Conveners of the each Chapter should submit its report in the prescribed format (CHAPTER REPORT) covering all the activities for the period 1st of April of the previous year to 31st March of the current year, to the NSI Headquarters on or before 31th August of the current year.
- f) A Special Committee comprising three senior members of the Society who are not associated with any of the Local Chapters constituted by the Headquarters will screen and evaluate the merit of the Chapter Reports and award Points based on a predetermined score as given below.
- g) The activities reported should not be of the professional lectures delivered by the office bearers themselves. Participation of all members of the Chapter should be encourages. If the activity has not been done under the NSI banner, it should not be included in the report. Activities done with students as a normal part of their curriculum cannot be labelled as NSI activities. It is preferable to have members from several institutions involved in NSI activities for wider outreach. For an activity to be counted there should have been at least 20 participants including the audience.
- f) The prize money will have an upper limit of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) to winning chapters depending on the availability of funds. The prize money should be utilized for the activities of the Chapter and a utilization certificate is to be submitted to the headquarters within a year of the award.
